## Swivel seat

1. Seat is operated mechanically with a lever.\*
2. Seat is swivelled outwards manually by the customer over the doorsill.
3. Getting in and out of vehicles is comfortable and easy.

## Lift-up seat

1. The lift-up seat is electrically powered for maximum comfort.\*
2. Seat swivels outwards over the doorsill.
3. Seat can be adjusted to the preferred height.
4. Lifting and lowering functions can also be operated by a wired remote control.

## Swivel seat

The Toyota swivel seat facilitates getting in and out of vehicles comfortably and easily. A swivel base is combined with either a low construction seat or the modified original seat. The seat can be swivelled outwards manually over the doorsill with a lever that is attached to the base. For lower roof height vehicles, the swivel base is attached to a specially designed low construction seat, which is a thinner version of the standard seat. In this case, the low construction seat is covered with the same fabric as the original standard seat that matches the vehicle interior. If headroom is not a concern, the swivel base is attached to the original seat, which only needs to be slightly modified. In either case, mobility adaptations will not alter the comfort or the interior style of your vehicle.



## Lift-up seat

The Toyota genuine lift-up seat makes getting in and out of vehicles considerably easier. The lift-up seat is a powered, outwards swiveling car seat lift, specially designed for Toyota vehicles that have a higher step up. The lift-up seat comes with the same fabric as the original standard seat to match the vehicle's interior. The lowering and lifting of the seat is operated with a switch on the side of the seat or with a wired remote control. The sliding and the reclining of the seat inside the vehicle are also operated with switches situated on the side of the seat.



## Dedicated to customers through partnership

Through a partnership with Toyota, Autoadapt can provide customers with a complementary range of mobility products and adaptations not available at Authorised Toyota Centres. Autoadapt is a Swedish manufacturer of mobility adaptation products which focuses on quality from design, through engineering, production development and customer service.

The Autoadapt Pan-European network, selected carefully by Toyota together with Autoadapt Sweden, is working with Toyota Centres to propose quality solutions. Toyota mobility centres will guide customers in the logistics of obtaining the adaptations fitted by Autoadapt. **Carolift**  
An electrically powered wheelchair hoist operated with a handheld unit for lifting and lowering the wheelchair as well as for swiveling it in and out of the vehicle.



**Carospeed**  
Floor mounted hand control unit for accelerator and brake, through a mechanical link suitable for people with impaired leg function. A set of primary control functions can be integrated into the unit: indicators, hazard lights, windscreen washer and wiper, headlights, etc.



**Steering device**  
Suitable for drivers who steer with one hand and use a hand control unit for acceleration and braking. There are a variety of handgrip alternatives available for this device.



**Roof spider**  
A storage box on your rooftop to transport a wheelchair. The Roof spider can be loaded from either side of the vehicle so it makes no difference if you are a driver or a passenger. Just press the button that corresponds to the side of the Roof spider that you want to access by a wired remote control. The design is ideal for foldable, manual wheelchairs up to 25 kg. By storing the wheelchair on the roof you save the space in the back for luggage, groceries, etc.
