

THE CARONY STORY



Caro 1983

This is the first "Carony" model, built on a height adjustable pillar stand, like those found on office chairs. Here you can also see the original swivel base Caro, that later developed to become our Turnout.

Caro 1988

The pillar stand was exchanged for an X-construction, which improved the height adjustability and made it more stable. A new type of brake was added along with some other improvements.



"Carony" 1992

Here is the first model resembling the Carony of today. It has the U-shaped base with a new frame work and the height adjustment cylinders. This one is docked to a pre-historic Turny!



CARONY 12"

The Carony 12" of today (from 1992). The rear wheels were replaceable for optional wheels of 20". But what we really needed was to develop a version with 24" driving wheels.



CARONY 24"

The Carony, with 24" driving wheels, came in 2001 as an easy to drive wheelchair for our active wheelchair occupants. Autoadapt had now two choices of Carony's to offer.



2004: The Carony version, **CARONY₁₂ fixed** only in combination with the Turny.



CARONY Kids

2004: Carony with a 40 cm deep Kids seat. The seat that grows as the child grows.
